

HENHAM STEAM & COUNTRY SHOW CARAVAN & CAMPING TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. On submitting your pitch application, you accept the Terms and Conditions on behalf of yourself, all of your party and any guests. Submission of an application does not necessarily mean acceptance.
2. Special requirements must be made in writing and will be considered by the Organisers. You will be notified if we are able to accommodate your requests.
3. The Caravan Steward will allocate a site pitch for you, but we reserve the right to change this at any time (**spacings 8 mtr centres towbar to towbar with all tow vehicles to be placed at rear of caravan**)
4. You are required to keep your site pitch and immediate surrounding area free from rubbish and debris. At the end of the event weekend, you will leave your pitch clean and totally free of any rubbish. There are plenty of disposal points around the site.
5. Pitches are available from 10.00am on the day before the event and must be vacated by 10.30am on the day after the event You are requested to stay in position until at least 4 pm on Sunday. If you need to leave before this time you must exit via **Gate E** or as directed.
6. You, all the members of your party and any guests are required to immediately abide by and carry out any instructions given to you by any event steward, police, security officer or other official.
 - a) Please note that under the provisions of the relevant Road Traffic Acts, the site is treated as being the same as a public highway and the same requirements for insurances, driving licences and road fund licences apply. Where fitted, safety belts must be worn.
 - b) Under the Motor Vehicles (Compulsory Insurance) Regulations, all mechanically propelled vehicles, irrespective of size or type, must have an insurance policy covering liability to third parties as a minimum for the duration of the whole of the event period.
7. All pets or other animals must be kept on a lead and under full control and you always remain fully responsible for them. The exercising of animals in areas within the showground but outside the event site is prohibited.

You and your party will act responsibly and not inconvenience other users of the site. You are liable for any damage caused as a direct or indirect result of your presence, activities or behaviour on site.

No bonfires, ground level barbecues, Chinese lanterns, drones, or fireworks are permitted.
8. We reserve the right to change the location of the event. Should this occur, you will be notified.
9. Any complaint arising before the weekend must be notified to the caravan steward as soon as it is known to you. Complaints arising during the event must be notified to the event office. No complaints will be accepted afterwards, but we welcome constructive remarks that may help to plan future events.
10. We accept no liability for loss or damage to your property, possessions or damage to any vehicle however caused.
11. We reserve the right to refuse entry to the site to any person.
12. Quiet site – no noise is to be made after midnight by any person(s) or equipment. Generators are to be switched off by midnight. Please respect this as you will be escorted from the site immediately if you are disturbing your neighbours, other campers, or any other persons.
13. Henham Steam Rally Events Ltd accepts no responsibility for Covid 19, any other pandemic or illness, however caused.
14. You are responsible for organising your own transport for yourself and your party, to and from the event.
15. Wristbands must be worn to gain entry. Those not wearing wristbands, over the age of 8 years, will be charged the daily rate at point of entry to the site.
16. ENVIRONMENT – We ask that you respect the environment generally but in particular that you do not supply or employ single use plastics during the event.
